

Town of Ellery 2011 Youth Recreation Program



The Bemus-Ellery Youth Recreation Program will sponsor its 25th annual summer Recreation Program from 10:00am - 1:00 pm, weekdays July 5th through July 29th.

We will be holding the program at the Bemus Point Elementary School. Children will be bused to all activities except swimming at the Bemus Beach.

This program is open to children who have completed kindergarten up to those who **will be** attending sixth grade in the fall. A donation of **\$30.00** per child for the program is requested and is payable on **Registration Day (July 1st)**. Refunds will not be given. Checks should be made out to: **Town of Ellery**.

****NEW CHANGES THIS YEAR**** If you wish for you and/or your child to attend the **WALDAMEER** trip on July 20th, we are asking for **\$10 per person to be brought the day of registration**.

CHAPERONES: We will take up to 10 (free ticket) chaperones, **BUT YOU MUST RIDE THE BUS** to receive a free ticket.

FOR PAYING CHAPERONES (WHO WILL DRIVE THEMSELVES): We ask that this be a special day at the park with your registered child and his/her registered friends only. If other siblings that are not registered come and need personal/medical help, it will take your attention away from those you agreed to chaperone.

Chaperones **may** have up to 5 children, depending on the age group you are given.

We will meet at the bus garage at 8:45 a.m. for Check-In. Buses will return home around 5:00 p.m. Another notice will be sent as a reminder with more information as the time draws near.

This year's activities include: Swimming at the Bemus Beach, Mini Golf/Rock Climbing Wall at Midway, Bowling at Fountain Bowl, Horseback Riding at Grandview Stable, Athletic Events, Games, Contests, Arts and Crafts, Fireman's Day in the Bemus Park and much more. Our larger trips this year include Waldameer Park (water and amusement), and ice skating at the Jamestown Savings Bank Ice Arena. These trips will be the only activities for the day. The entire group will participate if they attend. Two buses will be provided to ensure transportation for all. We will need 3 or 4 chaperones who ice skate for the Ice Arena, also.
